If you lost livestock you may be eligible for assistance through the LIP program

- LIP provides assistance for livestock deaths in excess of normal mortality

If you have a loss:

A notice of loss will need to be completed (CCC-852) within 30 calendar days of **“when loss is apparent”**

* Please call the office at (209) 722-4119 Ext. 108 to complete the form

Complete an acreage report (FSA-578) if one has not already been done

Areas of Assistance:

- Livestock death losses due to wildfire driven by high winds

Application For Payment:

In order to calculate a payment documentation of livestock loss will need to be submitted to the FSA office no later than 90 calendar days after the end of the calendar year. Also a signed Application for payment (CCC-852 Part H)

Timeline:

Within 30 calendar days from when the loss is first apparent file CCC-852 and complete an acreage report

Provide documentation of all livestock death for the calendar year, disaster and non-disaster

Complete application for payment within 90 days of end of calendar year

Important Info:

Need cattle counts of adult and also a count of non-adult under 400 pounds to complete the Notice Of Loss (CCC-852)

Normality for adult cattle is 1.5% and cattle less than 400 pounds is 2%

Payment limitation of \$125,000 is combined with LIP and LFP payments
